MISSION POSSIBLE PROJECT

The Building work started last Monday.

The cabin has been demolished behind church and the area has been cleared ready to start on the footings for the new Annexe this week.

Worship will take place in the Lounge until at least the end of the contract work, which is scheduled for completion on 2nd November.

The Church front door is no longer in use, except as an emergency Fire Exit.

Our temporary main entrance is now the Hall door at the other side of the building.

If anybody is available to help clear the Vestry on Thursday this week, ready for work to commence on the new Front Entrance and Foyer over the Summer holidays, please see David.

The whole project should be finished by the end of November. Hall, Lounge, Kitchen & Toilets will be in use as normal whilst the work progresses.

We are delighted to report that we received another grant last week: £2,500 from the Rank Foundation Pebble Fund.

That brings the total secured to date to £411,000. Only £14,000 short of the £425,000 target now!

However, the National Churches Trust are not able to support us.
